**Regulations for administration and  
membership of the Mechatronics Society  
in Uzbekistan.**



## Chapter 1: General Provisions

Article 1: The name of this Society is "Mechatronics Society of Uzbekistan" (hereinafter referred to as the Society).

Article 2: The Society is a non-profit organization established in accordance with the MechaUz project funded by Erasmus+, promote industry-university cooperation.

Article 3: The Society takes the national administrative region as its organizational area.

Article 4: The Society shall be located in the area where partner of MechaUz are located, and may set up branches upon approval by the partners of the project.

Article 5: The tasks of this Society are as follows:

- Promote the application and research of Mechatronic technologies.
- To support individuals or public or private organizations to solve problems in Mechatronics and Robotics.
- Organize academic activities to promote Mechatronics and Robotics.
- Publish conference journals and compile and print materials and books related Mechatronics and Robotics.
- Establish various research groups to promote Mechatronics activities related industries.
- Research and development of engineering technology.
- Organize relevant industrial vocational and professional training matters.
- Handle other matters related to the Society.

## Chapter 2: Members

Article 7: The members of this Society are divided into the following categories:

- Members from MechaUz partners: Anyone who agrees with the purpose of the Society and is over 20 years old must contact the coordinator. After approval by the Administration, a member becomes Members from MechaUz partners.
- Members from non-partners of MechaUz: Any organization or group that agrees with the purpose of this Society must contact to Coordinator. Administration should learn the Members from non-partners in the meeting, After approval by the Administration, a member becomes Members from non-partners of MechaUz.
- Student members: Those who agree with the purpose of the Society and have student status must contact to Coordinator. After approval by the Administration, it becomes a student member.
- Honorary members: Those who have made special contributions to the Society and are approved by the Administration are honorary members.



- Sponsoring members: Groups or individuals who donate money to support the work of the Society are sponsoring members.

Article 8: Members have the right to vote, elect, be elected, and remove in every meeting. Members have the right to nominate one representative to exercise membership rights. However, student members, honorary members, and sponsoring members do not have the rights.

Article 9: Members have the obligation to abide by the Society's articles and rules.

Article 10: If a member violates articles of Society or fails to comply with the resolutions of the general meeting, he or she may remove.

Article 11: The activities of the members are as follows:

- Establishing and changing the articles of Society.
- Elect and remove coordinator.
- Decide on annual work plans, activities of Society.
- Decide on the expulsion of members (member representatives).
- Decide on other major matters related to the rights and obligations of members.

Article 12: The functions and powers of the Administration are as follows:

- Determine the qualifications of members (member representatives).
- Formulate annual work plans, reports and other activities related to Society.
- Other matters that should be implemented.

### **Chapter 3: Meeting**

Article 13: The general meeting of members (member representatives) is divided into two types: regular meetings and temporary meetings, which are agreed by the Administration.

Regular meetings are held once a year.

The meeting is convened at the request of more than one-tenth of the members (member representatives).
